Purpose & Vision

- **Responding to the Jubilee:** In line with Pope Francis' call for the 2025 Jubilee of Hope.
- **Core Mission:** Express concrete pastoral care for migrants through cultural exchange and Eucharistic celebration.
- **Social Value:** Highlight Taiwan's multicultural harmony and deepen mutual understanding among locals, migrant workers, and new immigrants.



Event Overview

- **Venue:** Taoyuan City Arena
- **Attendance:** Estimated 7,000; actual turnout nearly 8,000
- **Participants:** Migrant workers, new immigrants, international students, and local faithful from the Philippines, Vietnam, Indonesia, Thailand, and Taiwan

- **CONCELEBRATION**
Led by bishops from multiple countries with multilingual translation.
- **CHOIR**
Over 300 members from various nationalities forming a multilingual choir.
- **ATMOSPHERE**
Solemn, warm, and spiritually uplifting — offering a sense of belonging for migrants far from home.
